The pFurnald (1856)/Jason Dame (1872) foundation is across the road to the SW. If it was the residence of Frederick B. Fernald in 1854 and 1856, then it was originally the residence of William Thompson Jr., who occupied it during the years 1813-1853. Another pFoundation is just SE of the cemetery - it apparently no longer existed by the time the 1856 and 1872 maps were created; it could have contributed burials to this cemetery, but it was not the *William*

Thompson Jr (1813-1853)/Frederick Fernald (1854, 1856) residence. The pLewis Trafton (1856, 1872) residence does not appear to have produced any burials.
