

Town of Shapleigh- 2017 Paving Bid

Invitation to bid BITUMINOUS PAVING FOR THE 2017 SEASON – **BIDS must be submitted by 7:00 pm on Tuesday, June 6, 2017.**

The Town of Shapleigh will receive sealed bids for the Bituminous Paving until at which time all bids will be opened and publicly read aloud.

All bids shall be based upon the price available to, and used by, the bidders as of **Friday, June 2, 2017**. Further, anyone submitting a bid shall agree thereby to pass along to the Town of Shapleigh any discounts, rebates or subsidies available as a result of abnormal or seasonal market conditions.

Estimated tonnage: to be used for the **Southern District**

- **Coley Trafton Road Project- 2,560' x 19'**
 - 2,560' x 19' Surface/Overlay = 460 T
- **Walnut Hill Road Project- 3,630' x 21'**
 - Shim = 400 T
 - Surface/Overlay = 480 T
- **County Road Project-**
 - Shim 1620' x 20' 6"= 180 T
 - Overlay 5,620' x 20' 6" = 800 T

Estimated tonnage *to be used for the Northern District*

- **Mann Road Project-**
 - Full depth reclamation 3,230' at 21' wide = 7,600 s.y.
 - 2" of base mix – approximately 850 T
 - 1" of surface mix – approximately 425 T
- **Nason Road Project-**
 - Full depth reclamation 4,450' at 20' wide = 9,900 s.y.
 - 2" base mix approximately 1,100 T
 - 1" Surface mix = 550 T

In addition to paving:

- Approximately 400 cy crushed gravel shoulders
- Approximately 25 Ton of Handwork

Submit price per tonnage. All bids must include the following:

- Sweeping the road prior to paving
- Using the appropriate traffic signs
- Providing traffic control
- Providing weigh slips
- All equipment must meet MDOT standards

The Town of Shapleigh reserves the right to waive all informalities in bids, to accept any bid or portion thereof, or to reject any and all bids should it be in its best interest to do so.

All bids shall be held by the Board of Selectmen not to exceed 30 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids, investigating the qualifications of the bidders, and then awarding the contract. The successful bidder(s) will be required to provide a certificate of insurance, maintain in full force and effect during the term of the contract, worker's compensation insurance (statutory amounts) auto liability insurance (\$500,000.00 single limit coverage), and public liability insurance (\$400,000.00 single limit coverage).
