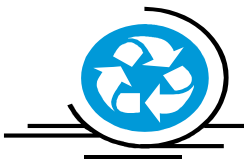


Items for the lower level that require a disposal fee include but are not limited to the following:

- Building materials
- Shingles wood or asphalt
- Insulation
- Sheetrock
- Mattress
- Furniture
- Rugs
- Tires
- Steel
- Kitchen appliances, TV's and computers
- Propane tanks
- Refrigerators
- Wood Stumps
- Waste oil
- Lawn Mowers
- Batteries - vehicle



Upper level –

Household and Kitchen trash are disposed of in the compactor at the upper level.

There is no charge for household trash or Recyclables as identified in this flyer.

YOU must have a valid Transfer Station sticker on your vehicle prior to disposing of your refuse.

A list of the disposal fees is available at the Town hall or from the Attendant at the lower level.

Items NOT accepted at the Transfer Station

- Fuel tanks
- Ammunition
- Auto bodies & frames
- Rail Road Ties
- Telephone Poles
- Pesticides
- Paint thinners
- Gasoline
- Diesel Fuel
- Anti-freeze
- Asbestos
- Tiles made prior to 1980
- Styrofoam
- Cans or containers with toxic wastes such as contamination, fuel, insecticides or paint thinner
